Attached, you will find some very important information that needs your prompt attention. Please review the information with your child as well.



Attendance

Attendance is very important! Please make sure your child is present and on time daily. The school day begins at 7:35 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m. Students will be marked tardy after 8:15 a.m. If your child is absent, please send a note to the school for the day of the absence. If your child is sick, please keep them at home until they are well.

Read to Achieve Program

The state of North Carolina has implemented a program called Read to Achieve for 3rd grade students. The goal of this program is to ensure that every student reads at or above grade level by the end of 3rd grade. By law, your child must pass the reading portion of the End of Grade test in order to be promoted to 4th grade. If he/she doesn't pass, he/ she will have opportunities to retest. Summer Camp will also be an option. However, if your child doesn't pass the test, there is a possibility that he/she could be retained in 3rd grade. Although math is not included in this law, math is still very important and your child will be expected to pass the test.

Homework

Homework is very important! Please read with your child each day for at least 30 minutes! Your child will be assigned homework Monday-Friday. He/ she will be expected to return the completed homework to school inside the "Homework Folder" the following day. I will collect homework daily. Each afternoon, your child must copy his/ her homework from the board and write it in his/her Student Planner. It is your child's responsibility to make sure he/ she has all materials or books needed for homework that night. If your child does not bring in homework, he/ she will have a consequence. Please make homework a priority and make sure your child gets the homework completed. Feel free to assist your child with homework by answering questions, but please refrain from completing the homework for him/ her. Homework is to be done in your child's handwriting to receive a grade. Please remember that homework will be an extension of what was taught in class and will be assigned to benefit your child. Please sign the Student Planner daily.

ClassDojo

ClassDojo is my preferred method of contact with parents and students. It is a classroom communication app used to connect parents, teachers, and students. I will post announcements, links, photos, videos, etc. I will also send messages to you and you can send messages to me. ClassDojo is a great tool to help us communicate and stay connected throughout the school year so please connect to the class if you are not already connected. If you have questions, please let me know.

Binders

Binders will be sent home daily with your child. It will include class notes, assignment homework, etc. Please make sure that your child takes care of his/ her binder and brings it to school each day. This binder will help your child stay organized.
